Vessels are operated by members in detachments (Basic or Advanced Water Operator Trained)

West Coast Marine Services in Nanaimo supports the Patrol Vessels

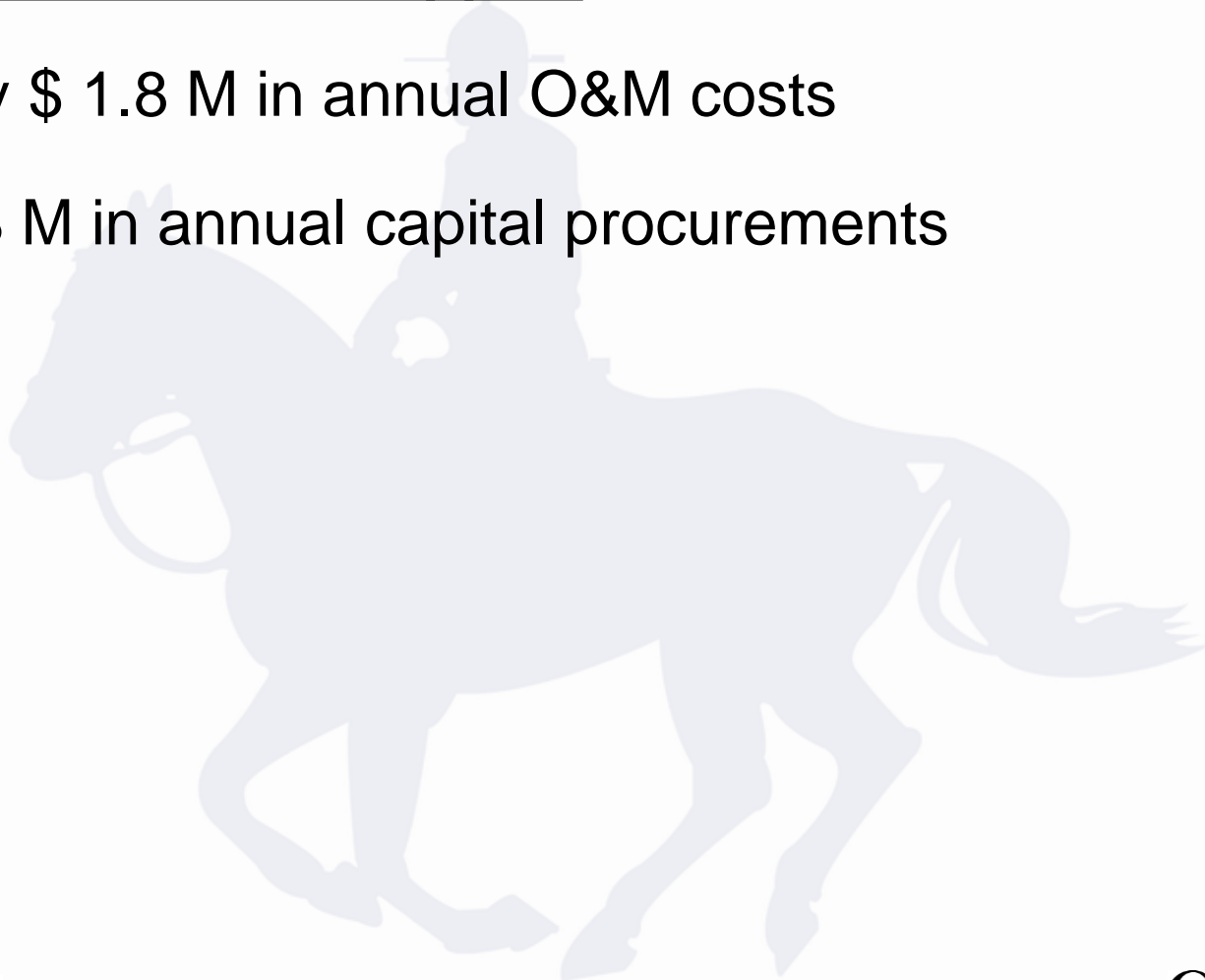
Supported by Fleet Managers in each Division, technically supported by 2 Marine Technicians for the country



Annual Budget for Fleet Support

Approximately \$ 1.8 M in annual O&M costs

Average \$ 3.8 M in annual capital procurements
