The purpose of Amendment 002 is to answer questions received, make administrative changes and extend the solicitation closing date.

1. Questions and Answers

The following questions were asked and the answers are included herein:

Question		Response
Q4	At 4.2.2.1, please confirm that the heading of this article means the same as "Eligible Mandatory Criteria" since this is the term used for the PBCP process?	That is correct and will be amended to reflect the proper term.
Q5	At Annex A, Appendix 1, 2.1.1.1, please confirm that there will be no live rounds in any of the list of rounds under 2.1.1.1?	<p>The Munition Scrap Flashing capability is not intended to treat live rounds or live items.</p> <p>All Ammunition Salvage and Munition Scrap items will be inspected by qualified personnel prior to being processed by the equipment, to ensure live items are not inadvertently introduced into the equipment.</p> <p>The equipment must be able to withstand the explosive limits specified in Annex A, Appendix 1, Sections 2.1.1.4, 2.1.1.5 and 2.1.1.6, which are specified on a per batch or per cycle basis (see Amendment 1).</p>
Q6	At Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.1.1, please provide a summary of chemicals contained in each of the items listed? Alternatively please provide additional description of the items in order that the Bidder may determine the chemicals contained.	<p>Due to the large variety of munition scrap and ammunition salvage items requiring disposal in the DND inventory, it is not possible to specify a summary of the chemical compositions expected. It is therefore recommended that Bidders propose pollution abatement system (PAS) components suitable to address the burn-off of energetic residue remaining from standard high explosive mixtures and single / double / triple base propellants.</p> <p>The PAS proposed must include the components specified in Section 2.1.8.1 as a minimum, at sizes / capacity suitable to accommodate the rated throughput of the flashing furnace equipment.</p>
Q7	At Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.3.1, this requires the equipment to operate on 600 VAC. This may prove unnecessary and result in the additional cost of providing a step-down transformer. Suggest that assuming mains power is available at 120, 208 and 600 VAC that it be left to the Contractor to propose which power feed is most appropriate.	Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.3.1 is amended per above.

Question		Response
Q8	At Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.3.5, please confirm that the engine used in the generator must meet Part 5 article 5.2.5?	Correct. The onboard generator engine must meet environmental standards specified in Part 5, Section 5.2.5.
Q9	At Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.8.1, please confirm that the equipment is not required to meet DND stack emission levels?	Since the flashing furnace equipment is only intended to treat energetic residue from munition scrap and ammunition salvage, and not intended to treat live items, only the PAS components specified in Annex A, Appendix 1, Section 2.1.8.1 are mandatory. The equipment does not need to meet DND stack emission standards.
Q10	At Annex A, Appendix1, 2.1.8.1 b, please confirm that the filter system is required to be 99.997 % effective at meeting the requirement for .3 micron particles. It should be noted that no filter system can be designed to meet 100%	The recommended filter efficiency of 99.997% for .3 micron particle matter is acceptable.

Electrical (wiring) diagrams must be provided.
