SOLE SOURCE JUSTIFICATION:

With the building control software being proprietary, only one firm is capable of performing the contract without replacing the current software package and then reprogramming the building controls to integrate with the replacement software. This would be extremely disruptive to building operations and considerable more costly than continuing with the current supplier. The time requirement on the part of the AAFC facility maintenance staff alone to support a reconfiguration of replacement software would be extremely onerous.
